Here's a quick guide to emergency services here in Stuttgart. The most important numbers are 112 for an ambulance or the fire brigade and 110 for the police.

## Emergencies

Germany doesn't use 911. The two most important numbers you should know are **112** and **110**.

### 112

Call for emergency medical assistance, an ambulance, a rescue, and the fire brigade. This number works all over Europe.

### 110

Call to reach the police and report accidents. This number is specific to Germany.

## Medical emergency services

If you need medical assistance outside of normal office hours but it's not life threatening, you can call the following number:

116 117

This number is in operation Monday-Thursday 19:00 to 7:00, and Friday 14:00 until Monday 7:00. It also operates 24 hours a day holidays.

To call an ambulance for a situation that's not life-threatening, use this number:

19222

You can also go the [Marienhospital](#) without an appointment Monday-Thursday 19:00 to 7:00 , Friday 14:00 to 7:00, and 7:00 to 1:00 on Saturday, Sunday and holidays.
